Profiad:

The position is initially on a short term basis covering a period of absence but it is highly likely that there will be hours on a longer term basis and this position provides an excellent opportunity for someone with a passion for working with animals to pass on their skills and expertise to our future generation.

Hours of Work: Part time - approximately 6 teaching hours per week
There may be the opportunity to undertake additional hours. We also welcome applications from those who are interested in fewer hours or part-time teaching.

Contract Type: Hourly Paid - Fixed Term initially to 31 March 2023
It is highly likely that there will be the opportunity to undertake hours on a longer term basis covering a period of maternity leave.

Qualifications:

- The successful candidate must be qualified to minimum Level 5 in a Animal Care related discipline.
- You will ideally hold a Teaching Qualification (e.g. PGCE). *If you do not hold a teaching qualification, Pembrokeshire College may support you in gaining a recognised teaching qualification should your employment become long term.*

Experience:

- You must have at least 2 years' experience working within the Animal Care industry.
- Ideally you will also have experience of either teaching or training, particularly young adults. Knowledge of Pearson (BTEC) qualifications would be advantageous, though not essential.

You could be required to teach a range of subjects ranging from level 1 to level 3. Course units to be delivered would include aspects of biology, animal behaviour, health, welfare, breeding, nutrition of varied animal species. Learners will have a learning experience which will be centred around practical activities and the underpinning knowledge, skills and attitudes which will prepare them for working in the animal industry or for progressing to Higher Education.

As the College's Animal Care courses will be delivered across various locations throughout Pembrokeshire, the successful candidate must have access to transport and may be required to undertake relevant training in order to be able to transport learners to offsite locations by minibus.
